



COVID-19 DECISION TREE

For students or staff members experiencing **ONE** or more of the following symptoms:

- Fever \geq 100.4
- Loss of taste or smell
- Shortness of Breath
- Difficulty Breathing
- New or worsening cough
- Headache
- Muscle/Body Aches
- Chills
- Sore Throat
- Nausea or Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Congestion/Runny nose

DO NOT ATTEND SCHOOL.
If already at school individual will be sent home and visit to primary care provider and/or COVID-19 test recommended.

When can I return to school?

WITH EXPOSURE

- Close contact with COVID-19 Positive individual (15 minutes or longer within 6 feet). Even with mask on.

COVID-19 POSITIVE TEST RESULT

MAY RETURN AFTER 10 DAYS HOME ISOLATION FROM POSITIVE TEST RESULT
AND
48 HOURS FEVER FREE WITHOUT FEVER REDUCING MEDICATION
AND
SYMPTOMS HAVE SIGNIFICANTLY IMPROVED

EXPOSURE WITH NO SYMPTOMS

MAY RETURN AFTER 10 DAYS HOME QUARANTINE, OR 7 DAYS IF THEY RECEIVE A NEGATIVE TEST RESULT FROM LAST KNOWN EXPOSURE DATE
AND
HAVE NO SYMPTOMS

****CONSULT DOCTOR IF SYMPTOMS DEVELOP FOR COVID-19 TESTING****

IF POSITIVE TEST RESULT SEE ABOVE GUIDELINES

HAS SYMPTOMS WITH NO COVID-19 TESTING DONE

MAY RETURN AFTER 10 DAYS HOME QUARANTINE
AND
48 HOURS FEVER FREE WITHOUT FEVER REDUCING MEDICATION
AND
SYMPTOMS HAVE SIGNIFICANTLY IMPROVED

EVEN IF A CLOSE CONTACT IS ASYMPTOMATIC AND/OR GETS A NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST THEY ARE REQUIRED TO HOME QUARANTINE FOR 10 DAYS, OR 7 DAYS IF THEY RECEIVE A NEGATIVE TEST RESULT.

NO EXPOSURE

NO CLOSE CONTACT OR POTENTIAL EXPOSURE

HAS SYMPTOMS DESCRIBED ABOVE WITH COVID-19 NEGATIVE RESULT

MAY RETURN AFTER SYMPTOMS HAVE SIGNIFICANTLY IMPROVED
AND/OR
48 HOURS FEVER FREE WITHOUT FEVER REDUCING MEDICATION

HAS CHRONIC/REOCCURRING SYMPTOMS THAT ARE SYMPTOMS DESCRIBED ABOVE WITH NO COVID-19 TESTING DONE

SYMPTOMS HAVE SIGNIFICANTLY IMPROVED
AND/OR
MAY RETURN 48 HOURS FEVER FREE WITHOUT FEVER REDUCING MEDICATION
OR
DOCTOR'S NOTE INDICATING ALTERNATIVE DIAGNOSIS (EX: SEVERE ALLERGIES, EAR INFECTION, ETC.)

SIMCHA, PARTIES & SOCIAL GATHERINGS POLICY

We will no longer require quarantine for faculty and students after attending simchas, parties, and social gatherings so long as the gatherings meet the following criteria:

- The event takes place 100% outside (excluding the religious ceremony of a simcha)
- All food must be served individually (no buffet)
- No dancing
- Masks and social distancing required

TRAVEL POLICY

There is no longer a quarantine required after travel.
