Students are required to read a minimum of three books over the summer. One of the books can be read to them. At least one of the required books should come from the selections listed below.

Students are required to write a letter about one of the books they read. For **extra credit**, students can read and write letters for as many books as they would like. Choose any 3 of these books or a book that isn't on the list. They are in order of difficulty starting with easier ones and getting gradually harder. You can order these books from Amazon or get them from your local library. It is great to get a library card over the summer and make going to the library a summer activity. There your child can choose a few books each week to read.
