- XtraMath – a session everyday to improve the students quick recall and automaticity of basic math facts.

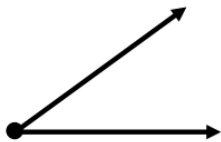

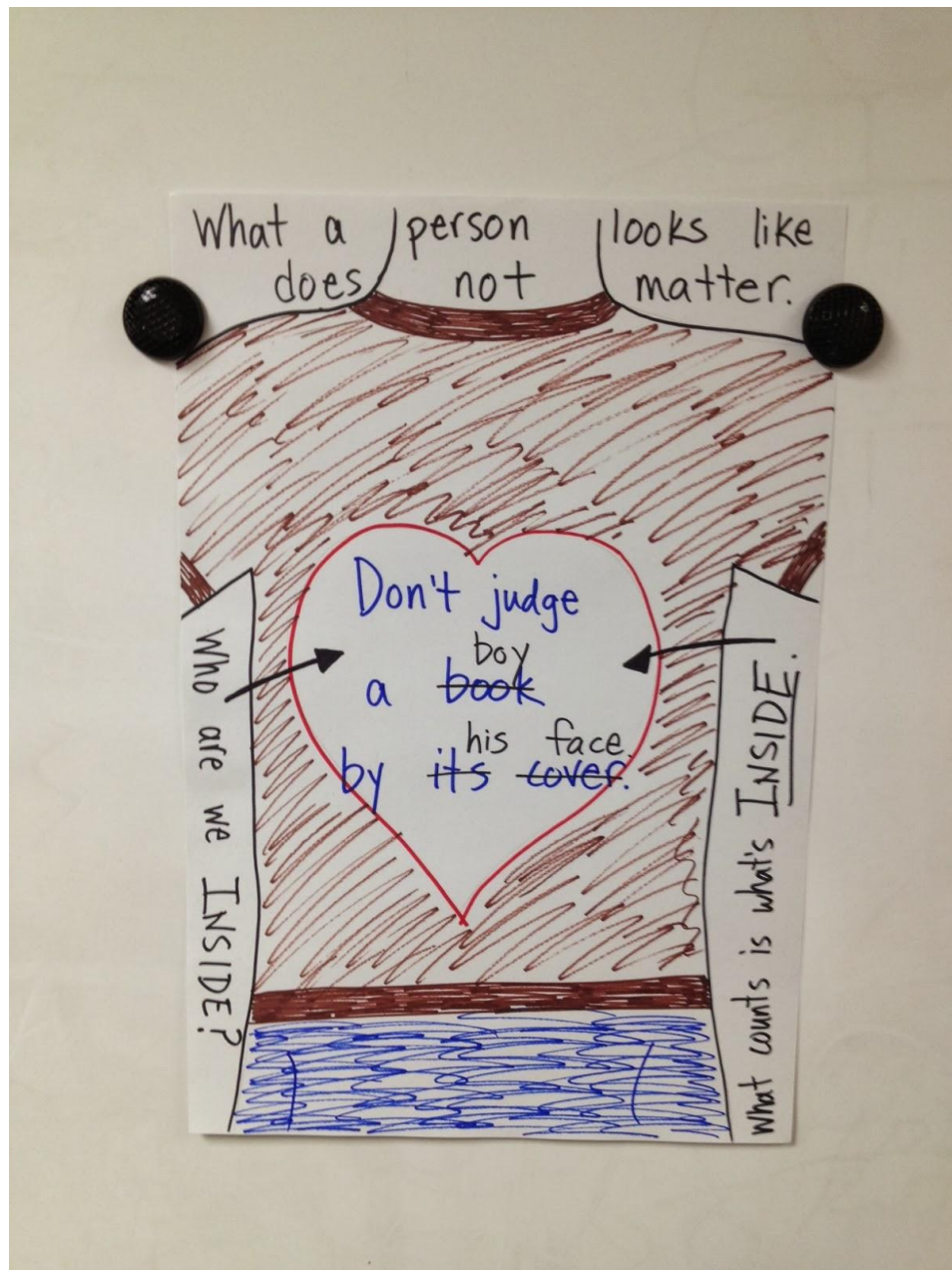
